1. Kitabs:

Notes:

1. Refer to the “Notes on Islamic Studies” section of the syllabus. The guidance mentioned is important and teachers are to implement these guidelines.
2. There will only be two Kitabs that will be covered in the Islamic Studies lesson throughout the year; An-Nasihah – Book 6 and Understanding Taharah. The teacher will need to determine how many days each Kitab will be covered.
3. All the exercises of Understanding Taharah must be covered in an exercise book.

2. Practical Salaah:

1. Revision of the complete Salaah syllabus including Wudhu must take place at least three times a year.
2. Salaah needs to be covered practically with a lot of emphasis on “concentration & devotion” and Ta’deel e Arkaan.
3. Pupils must be encouraged to perform Salaah at home and teachers must monitor pupils closely during Salaah times in Madrasa.

My Salah Diary:

1. From this year, all children in Level 4 and above will be given a Salah diary.
2. The Salah diary will operate a points score system depending on whether a child performs Salah or not etc.
3. The aim of this is to motivate the children to perform Salah.
4. Although parents will administer the diary from home, teachers are expected to motivate their pupils to take this initiative seriously. A reminder can be given to pupils every few weeks, with the teacher checking this diary every so often and giving a prize to those pupils who are performing their Salah.
5. More details are available in the actual My Salah Diary”. Please refer to the diary for this.

3. Duas:

First revise the Duas from Reception to Level 6 as per the LTP.

The following new Duas need to be covered this year (from L7 Duas of My Prophet's Prayers):

	Name of Dua
1	Bidding Someone Farewell
2	Relief from Anxiety etc
3	When a Strong Wind Blows
4	When Experiencing Hot Weather
5	When Experiencing Cold Weather
6	At the Time of Thunder
7	At the Time of Heavy Rainfall

Some pupils (L7 from 2016/17) have already covered the above Duas. Thus, the pupils who have not covered them, must do so whilst revision of Duas is going on at the beginning of the year.

The entire class will also memorise the following Duas (from Level 8):

	Name of Dua
1	After Breaking One's Fast
2	When Afflicted by Misfortune etc.
3	When Entering Another Town
4	To Treat Flu etc.
