Stages of Ghusl	Order
Wet the mouth and nose using damp pieces of cotton wool	1
Dry the body, ensuring the private areas are covered at all times	
Wash the private area with a cloth whilst wearing gloves	
Make Wudhu, thereafter wash the beard and head	
Raise the top half of the body and gently rub the stomach, washing any waste	
Tilt the body onto its left side. Pour water and scrub with soap starting from the head	
Tilt the body onto its right side. Pour water and scrub with soap starting from the head
