I'tikaaf	A charity of about £1.50 given by Muslims to poor Muslims on Eid ul Fitr
Udhiyah	In the month of Ramadhan, Muslims offer special salah of 20 Rak'aat after Esha.
Sadaqatul Fitr	Literally meaning "the celebration of Sacrificing" it is celebrated on 10 th Dhul Hijjah and commemorates the sacrifice made by Ibrahim A.S and Ismail A.S
Taraweeh	To enter the masjid with the intention of staying in the masjid for a period of time. A person who does I'tikaaf is called a Mu'takif. I'tikaaf is mostly done in the last 10 days of Ramadhan.
Eidul Fitr	The name of the night before Eid ul Fitr
Eidul Adha	The Arabic word for 'Qurbani'. Muslims sacrifice an animal on Eid ul Adha to remember he sacrifice made by Ibrahim A.S and Ismail A.S
Laylatul Qadr	Translated as "the night of power". It is a special night that occurs in the last 10 odd nights of Ramadhan.
