Please answer the following questions:

1. Aisha's mother woke her up for school but she continued to sleep and shouted back "I will wake up after 10 minutes". Explain Aisha's behavior - What did she do wrong and what could she do to become a better person? (4)

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2. Mohammed's Madrasa teacher told the class to complete lesson 5 in their workbook on their own whilst he completes the register and marks the diaries. Mohammed immediately takes his pencil case out and finishes his work. He then starts helping the person next to him and they eventually start talking about what they are going to do during the weekend.

Explain Mohammed's behavior - What did he do right & wrong and what should he have done? (4)
