You may want to cover the "easier" pages by doing 2 pages a day, and spending more time over other pages.

Please sign off each page everyday, and return this booklet to the class teacher on the first day back. We will be using this to revise on the first one or two days.



Level 1

- ✓ Level 1 is the foundation towards reciting the Quran.
- ✓ Completing this booklet in the holidays is essential.
- ✓ If you want your child to progress and this resource to be productive, rather than rushing in the last 3-4 days, you <u>must</u> <u>do a little</u> everyday (one page).
- ✓ Devote a fixed time for this everyday the best time is early in the morning.
- ✓ Revisit the same page in the evening before your child's bedtime.

Spreading the learning over two sessions everyday is important.

- ✓ Every year, from all of our Level 1 classes, 1 or 2 pupils have to repeat the same class. This is due to a lack of consistency in efforts.
- ✓ Consistency on a daily basis is essential consistency allows "concepts" to slowly "sink in" and your child learns "organically". You cannot "rush the learning" of a whole year in a matter of a few weeks.

Concluding, the headteacher personally assesses all Foundation classes – it is to ensure everyone is on track. If you receive a letter regarding your child's progress, it is important you take relevant action.
