STEP 2	Enter Al Masjid ul Haraam and perform Tawaaf. Men must observe <i>QASR</i> / <i>RAML</i> and <i>IDHTIBA'</i> / <i>IHRAAM</i> .
STEP 3	After completing the Tawaaf, perform two Rak'aat <i>WAAJIB</i> / <i>FARDH</i> salaah preferably behind <i>AL HAJAR UL ASWAD</i> / <i>MAQAAM U IBRAHIM</i> .
STEP 4	Do <i>ISTILAAM</i> / <i>IDHTIBA'</i> of Al hajar ul Aswad after the Salaah.
STEP 5	Perform <i>SA'EE</i> / <i>TAWAAF</i> .
STEP 6	Shave or trim the hair for men. Women will only <i>TRIM</i> / <i>SHAVE</i> their hair.
