### 5. Clearly explain the rulings in the following two scenarios:

Scenario	Ruling
Fāțimah puts on a clean pad at the beginning time of 'Aşr Şalāh, on the last day of her Ḥayḍ. At Maghrib Şalāḥ time, her pad is still clean with no coloured discharge on it.	
'Āsiyah's Ḥayḍ finishes 8 minutes before the ending time of Suḥūr. She does not have sufficient time to make Ghusl.

1	Maryam has just turned 8. She is experiencing bleeding every month. This bleeding is classed as Istiḥāḍah.		
2	Ghusl is not necessary if you bleed less than 72 hours.		
3	If a pregnant woman experiences bleeding during her pregnancy, she must stop reading her Ṣalāh during those days.		
4	The minimum duration of Ḥayḍ is 10 days and 10 nights.		
5	The maximum duration of cleanliness between two menstrual bleeds is 15 days and 15 nights.
