The six steps of performing Umrah is written below. Cross out the INCORRECT answer. Step 1 has been done as an example for you. (7)

Step 1	Enter into the state of Ihraam for Umrah BEFORE /- AFTER the Meeqaat.
Step 2	Enter Al Masjid ul Haraam and perform Tawaaf. Men must observe QASR / RAML and IDHTIBA' / IHRAAM.
Step 3	After completing the Tawaaf, perform two Rak'aat WAAJIB / FARDH salaah preferably behind AL HAJAR UL ASWAD / MAQAAM U IBRAHIM.
Step 4	Do ISTILAAM / IDHTIBA' of Al hajar ul Aswad after the Salaah.
Step 5	Perform SA'EE / TAWAAF.
Step 6	Shave or trim the hair for men. Women will only TRIM / SHAVE their hair.
