	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Does not bring reward or punishment.</li> <li>• Performing it or leaving it out is the same.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Disliked by Allah and His messenger ﷺ.</li> <li>• If they do not believe it to be bad, they will remain a Muslim, but may be considered as a sinner.</li> </ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Something the Prophet ﷺ did, said, or encouraged.</li> <li>• Muslims do their best to perform these actions and consider it bad to leave them out.</li> </ul>
