In front of Mahram Males

From below the navel, up to and including the knees must be covered, even when alone.

In front of non-Mahram Males

From below the navel, up to and including the knees must be covered, even when alone.

In front of other Muslim Women

It is permissible for the spouses to look at any part of each other's bodies. However, this should be avoided unless necessary.

In front of non-Muslim women

From below the navel up to and including the knees is the awrah and must be covered.
