Assalamualaykum, Dear parent / well-wisher,

This booklet is about our Madrasah premises that we IA hope to renovate in the near future.

We hope you will make lots of Duas and support our appeal.

About us:

- Madrasah Tajweedul Quran is the educational arm of Al-Ansaar Welfare & Education, a UK registered charity.
- We started with a little Madrasah of just 30 pupils in December 2001. Today, we have not only grown to a Madrasah catering for nearly 400 children, over the last decade we have almost revolutionised Maktab teaching, both locally and nationally. Scores of Ulama, Imams, teachers and management members have benefited from our resources, expertise, teacher training, (free) consultancy, and much more.
- This has all been achieved with Allah's help and the support and Duas of our
- supporters, well-wishers, parents, teachers, and all those associated with our Madrasah.
- As a Madrasah, we always try our best to put the child first. Everything about our syllabus, structure, teaching, is centred on the child. Everything is constantly reviewed, and we are always looking to improve on what we already have in place.



We pray to Allah that he accepts our efforts and grants us wisdom and sincerity. Ameen.

Our premises:

- We have been in our current premises (140-142 Garstang Rd) for over 17 years, and in this period no major renovation work has ever been carried out.
- The building is old, and to put it frankly, it is quite dilapidated. Rather than constantly carrying out little repairs / refurbishments here and there, after consulting various professionals, the advice received is to carry out a full renovation of our premises. This will result in more efficiency and cost saving; it will also provide a better learning environment for us all.

Our plans:

The following are plans that do not require planning consent, and thus is something that we IA hope to carry out in the near future.

- 1. To carry out a complete internal refurbishment of all classrooms, this includes skimming / plastering, décor, plumbing and electrical work.
- 2. In particular, the basement classrooms need special attention.
- 3. Improve the lighting of all classrooms and communal areas.
- 4. New doors throughout the Madrasah.
- 5. Upgrade the CCTV and fire systems.
- 6. Improve the toilet / Wudhu facilities.
- 7. Utilise "dead space" in the Madrasah at the same time remove all unnecessary structures/fittings that are in some classrooms (fireplaces, chimneys, fixed wooden structures etc). Removing "dead space" in certain classrooms will increase space by up to 15-20%.
- 8. Create digital learning infrastructures for the future (internet access, smart boards, screens etc in all classrooms).

In addition to the above, we IA also hope to carry out the following, subject to planning approval:

- 9. An extension on both sides of the Madrasah premises and towards the rear.
- 10. The right-hand side extension will be larger than the left side extension.

- 11. The extension on the right and rear will primarily serve two purposes:
 - a) Create more room for our prayer hall (currently our older children cannot be accommodated at once for Salaah with congregation).
 - b) Create a dedicated large room for assemblies and merits (the latter is when children play every 5-6 weeks).
 - c) This area could also be used for five daily prayers, Jumuah, Taraweeh, Ramadhan etc.
- The extension on the left will also increase the prayer hall, and it will also increase the basement area, creating more space for more toilets and improved ablution facilities.
- In addition to these two extensions, we also hope to have much smaller extensions at both entrances – creating a shoe rack/open area which can also be used as a waiting area on rainy days. These two smaller extensions will also relieve the congestion that we see at home time, as there will IA be plenty of space for our children.
- The aim of the extension is not to create extra classroom space; rather it is to improve current facilities by providing more space/improved facilities. Our proposed extension should not cause any problems for our neighbours.

Estimated cost & total raised so far:



This is not taking into consideration the cost of replacing carpets, painting, and other educational electronic equipment).

Alhamd... we are proud of our prudent record to date, managing the Madrasah on a very tight budget. We IA hope to complete the renovation project with maximum efficiency.

We have so far raised £120,000.

Our fundraising strategy so far – "money box":

We as a Madrasah appreciate that families are always under pressure with regards to their finances. With the recent economic downturn, pandemic, cost of living etc, this has intensified even further.

To successfully complete our project with the support of our parents and keeping family finances in mind, we have given a "money box" to every child. The purpose of this is as follows:

- a) Please place your Lillah & Nafl Sadaqah in here. A little and frequent Sadaqah keeps us safe from calamities. <u>No Zakaat to be placed in this box.</u>
- b) Every so often we will remind pupils and parents to send this in to be emptied.
- c) We hope to raise £15,000 a year through these money boxes.
- d) This strategy will IA not overburden anyone. With your Duas and support we hope to raise at least 20% of the renovation cost through these money boxes.

- b) You can set up a standing order directly via your bank; simply give them our account details. **Ensure you quote as reference: Renovation.**
- c) If you can help us by giving professional advice on building work, plumbing, electrics, digital infrastructure etc, then please contact us. We

can then include you as part of our planning meetings (at this stage these would take place 2-3 times a year).

d) Do you have a fundraising idea you can take charge of? We are keen for parents to get involved as much as possible. Email us with your proposal.

Planning permission / target date:

We have set the year 2026 as our target date (subject to funds being in place).

Mr Zuned Vorajee, who is a Madrasah parent and who drew the plans for our premises in Deepdale and was also the project manager, will be assisting us again in drawing up new plans, gaining planning permission and ongoing support.

Concluding...

This is a large project with various challenges, and although it is scheduled for 2026, this will still consume a lot of time from now onwards. We ask you to make special Dua for its successful completion, and to support us as much as possible.

As we have more details, these will be sent out to parents.

The benefits of Sadaqah

Parents always ask us "what can be placed in the donation box". Lillah and Nafl Sadaqah can go here. Zakaat, Sadqat-ul-Fitr and the money given for Kaffarah, <u>cannot</u> be used for our renovation project.

a A little Sadaqah every day or on a regular basis brings great benefits.

Sadaqah is an Islamic term that means voluntary charity, such as a charitable act, charitable giving, or money given in charity with the intention of seeking the pleasure of Allah.

The following two Ahadith clearly display the benefits of Sadaqah.

"Give the Sadaqah without delay, for it stands in the way of calamity." (Tirmidhi 1887)


"Charity extinguishes (removes) sins just as water extinguishes fire." (Tirmidhi 2616)
